



Guide to completing the President's Choice Children's Charity (PCCC) grant application

APPLICATION DEADLINE: September 30, 2020

- All schools are requested to apply for funding from *President's Choice Children's Charity*
- Schools apply directly themselves, using the online grant submission form, and direct the funding to The Food Sharing Project. This funding becomes part of your school's budget for food from The Food Sharing Project for the school year
- Follow the guidelines below, and see the additional information in the appendices (low-income guide, school budget)

Starting the application

Before you start the application, check Appendix 2 (budget info) to see if your school is listed. If it is not listed, do not apply. Your school/program is not eligible, or we have satisfactory budget for your school. All other schools are strongly encouraged to apply – before the September 30 deadline

- Scroll down and click on the **Apply Now** button
- You will be taken to a *grantstream* login page
- Scroll down and click on **Begin a New Application**
- You will be provided with a username and password – *DO NOT LOSE THIS* – print or save it somewhere safe
- Click Continue

OVERVIEW (page 1)

- Complete this section with your school name, address, etc.
- **IMPORTANT:** After the address section, you will choose who to make the cheque payable to....fill in **THE FOOD SHARING PROJECT**. This is important so we have enough funding to supply all our schools for the entire school year. The cheque will still be mailed to your school, but will be made payable to our organization. Please be sure to get the name correct (e.g. Project, not Program) or we will not be able to cash the cheque
- Complete the remainder of this section, e.g. school enrolment, etc.
- For the question about percentage of low-income families, you can use the *Low Income by Neighbourhood* chart for the City of Kingston (Appendix 1), attached. To determine your neighbourhood, go to: <https://www.cityofkingston.ca/apps/community-census-profiles/> and click on "Neighbourhoods" in the blue banner to see a map

CONTACT (page 2)

- Complete this section with your contact information. Please carefully check your email address.

REQUEST (page 3)

- Complete the information requested
- For “meals provided” you can *choose either Breakfast or Lunch*. Just choose one, assuming you are using a bin program or grab and go program and food is placed once a day.
- For the budget items, please read the following carefully and refer to the correct columns on *Appendix 2 – Budget Information for PCCC Application*:
 - For the “**Forecast expenditures**” question, enter the amount in the **GREEN** column beside your school’s name on the *Budget Information* table
 - For the “**Provincial**” funding question, enter the number in the **YELLOW** column
 - For the “**Funding from other sources**” question, enter the number in the **ORANGE** column
 - The Application should automatically calculate the “**Budget Shortfall**” which should match the number in the **PURPLE** column
 - For the “**Amount Requested**” question, enter the same number as the “**Budget Shortfall**” (**PURPLE** Column)

SUMMARY (page 4)

- Review your application to ensure it is complete and accurate
- Tick the box beside the agreement (read it first)
- PRINT or otherwise save a copy of your application
- SUBMIT the application

COMPLETION

- We **do not** need a copy of the application, but please keep your copy on file.

WHEN YOUR GRANT IS AWARDED

- When you receive notification of your grant award, please let us know. You can simply forward the cheque to us by mail, or we can pick it up when we are delivering food to your school.
